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Wasatch Peaks Sponsors The Peak Challenge

The Peak Challenge is a self-paced trail challenge for Northern Utah trail lovers to set a goal to bag all four of our iconic local Peaks in one season. Ranging in elevation from Malans at 6980 feet all the way to Ben Lomond Peak at 9711 feet. Anyone who has completed any of these four peaks will tell you that they can be a bit of a challenge.

Participants choose when to complete each of the four peaks; Malans, Lewis, Mt. Ogden & Ben Lomond - just like the levels of the TFNU membership program. Peaks can be done any time, and in any order, between June 7 and October 14.

Whether you end up bagging just one or all four - participants will receive an exclusive peak sticker for each mountain top you reach and an exclusive sticker once all four peaks are completed. Participants bagging all four peaks during that time will also be recognized at the TFNU Fall Trail Mixer October 17 at the Monarch and receive an award.

Ultimate ID

With Ultimate ID, you can rest easy knowing you have daily credit monitoring by Experian, Equifax, and TransUnion Credit Bureaus.¹ With protection from Ultimate ID, you will also have access to:

Alerts you when a creditor requests your report at TransUnion.

Dark Web Internet Monitoring provides alerts on known historical breaches from the last 10 years.

Record critical information you may need to access in the event of a lost or stolen wallet.

Receive monthly alerts when a new score is available to view.

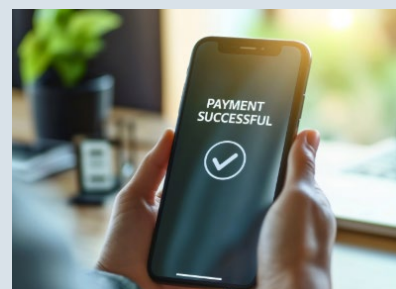

SEND Makes Receiving Money Faster

Getting money into your account just got faster. Wasatch Peaks has added SEND, a new instant payment feature powered by the FedNow Service. FedNow is a payment network developed by the Federal Reserve that allows participating financial institutions to move eligible payments in near real time, around the clock—including evenings, weekends, and holidays. For members, that means incoming funds from participating payment services, financial institutions, or peer-to-peer platforms can be available in your Wasatch Peaks account right away.



There's nothing you need to enroll in, activate, or turn on to receive eligible instant payments. SEND is already available within online banking, so when a qualifying payment is sent to your account, it will be processed automatically. This can be especially helpful when you are receiving money from services like Venmo, friends, family, or other payment providers and want quicker access to your funds without waiting for traditional processing times.

At this time, SEND supports receiving instant payments only. The ability to send instant payments from your Wasatch Peaks account is not yet available, but this is an important step toward offering more real-time payment options in the future. For now, members can enjoy the convenience of faster access when eligible funds are sent to their Wasatch Peaks account—automatically, securely, and without any extra steps.
